REDUCE, REUSE & IMPROVE



At the heart of our commitment to sustainability lies our state-of-the-art Reclaim Center, a cornerstone of our efforts to reduce waste and promote circularity within our operations. Through engineering and continuous innovation, we have transformed this facility into a hub of resource recovery, enabling us to recycle and repurpose scrap generated throughout our production processes.

Recognizing the significance of minimizing our ecological impact and maximizing resource efficiency, our primary goal is to attain an industry leading reclamation rate for the scrap generated within our operation. Through ongoing research and development initiatives, we are harnessing cutting-edge technologies and refining our methodologies to optimize resource utilization and minimize waste generation.

In tandem with our efforts to enhance our reclamation capabilities, we have also prioritized initiatives aimed at preventing scrap at its source. By implementing innovative design strategies and process optimizations, we are proactively addressing the root causes of waste generation within our operations. Through these concerted

efforts, we are not only advancing towards a more sustainable future but also fostering a culture of environmental stewardship that permeates every aspect of our organization.

Viaflex was able to make a substantial reduction in our environmental footprint in 2023 by reducing our annual kWh consumption by 1,686,765. This was made possible by the continued upgrades to our extrusion lines to convert from DC to AC energy. These updates are part of Viaflex's commitment to modernization of its operations that will have long lasting impacts to the environment.

In 2023 Viaflex was able to divert 20.69 tons of recyclable waste away from landfills in addition to our recycled product captured by our Reclaim Center.

Also in 2023 Viaflex modernized their Building Management Software to enhance our ability to identify additional areas of opportunity to lower our

carbon footprint. This update will allow us to measure our baseline energy consumption and provide the necessary reporting to develop our strategy to reduce wasted energy.



OCS is an industry led program that supports companies in their goal towards achieving zero resin loss in operations. Our joining OCS represents a comprehensive

initiative aimed at reducing and eliminating pellet and flake loss in the plastics industry. One crucial aspect of this initiative involves the



By defining standardized procedures, Viaflex will minimize pellet and flake loss, enhance productivity, and promote a culture of excellence across all departments. The implementation of SOPs not only fosters operational discipline but also contributes to the overall success of OCS.

As part of OCS, Viaflex has formed a dedicated committee to oversee and

drive the initiative forward. This committee comprises cross-functional representatives from different departments, ensuring a holistic approach to the sustainability

process. The committee is responsible for coordinating the implementation of SOPs, addressing challenges, and monitoring the progress of the initiative. By bringing together diverse perspectives and expertise, the committee fosters collaboration and ensures that the goals of OCS align with the overarching objectives of Viaflex.

To maintain the integrity and effectiveness of OCS, Viaflex has also initiated a series of internal audits. These audits serve as a proactive measure to





CLEAN WATER SECURITY PROJECT



Viaflex prioritizes sustainability and recyclability in the design processes, aiming to create products that align with environmentally conscious practices. Our ongoing efforts extend to the development of biodegradable solutions across multiple markets we serve. By integrating these principles into our design strategy, Viaflex is not only meeting the evolving demands of environmentally conscious consumers but is also positioning itself as a responsible and forward-thinking leader in the industry.

At a wastewater treatment facility in Sacramento, CA, 1,350,000 square feet

of Viaflex J30BB1 Liner Material was meticulously installed across 30 acres. This innovative application facilitates the storage of 6,250 tons of sludge, effectively preventing its seepage into groundwater. Once the water is free of sludge, it can be put back into the wastewater storage ponds before undergoing treatment within the facility ensuring a sustainable water management process.

This practice is crucial for preventing waste discharges that could threaten water quality, especially in California, where 85% of the population relies on groundwater.





CONTRIBUTIONS & VOLUNTEERING AT WORK
